1. Each entrant must submit one photograph with an explanation detailing when, where and why the photograph was taken in no more than 50 words.
2. Photographs must be in jpeg format minimum size of 4x6 inches (1800 x 1200 pixels) print quality or 300dpi and between 1MB and 2MB. Submissions that do not comply may be rejected.
3. Entrants accept that any image submitted to the competition may be used by the International Office in both print and website formats.
4. The photograph should be the entrants own work and should have been taken during 2009 in Scotland.

5. Obscene or inappropriate photographs will not be accepted and The International Office reserves the right to reject any photographs for any reason.

6. Prior to submitting a photograph of any identifiable individual, entrants should obtain the consent of such person and advise them of the purpose of the submission and that their photograph may be published by the International Office.
